**ST DOCHDWY'S CLEANING** is now on the second Thursday of each month, next on 14 October. Please stay after the service if you can help.



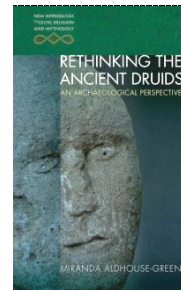
