HYMNS

Most ceremonies include 2 or 3 hymns. If they are long, you may want to reduce the number of verses, as long as it keeps the sense of the hymn and fits with the chosen tune.

These usually come:

2 Hymns

1 – at the start just after the priest gives the welcome

2 - near the end after the Lord's Prayer but before the blessing.

3 Hymns

1 – at the start just after the priest gives the welcome

2 – after the readings and sermon

3 - near the end after the Lord's Prayer but before the blessing.

Order of Service

The order of service needs to be prepared in conjunction with Fr Mark. We have some templates available to help you with this – please see the website or contact the Administrator.

You should email/send a draft copy to the Administrator at least 6 weeks before your wedding to be checked *before* it goes to the printers.

Readings

- You should choose 2 Bible readings, at least one of which should be from the New Testament.
- You can also choose a poem or other reading, but please check with the Administrator or Fr Mark that it is suitable.
